SportsWareOnLine – Continues its Rapid Growth

In three days over 350 NATA attendees from High Schools, Colleges, Professional

Teams and Outreach Clinics visited our NATA booth and expressed their interest in going online with SWOL to record, manage and report athlete data.

SWOL allows Athletic Trainers to off-load many repetitive tasks allowing the AT to focus on higher-value-add functions of athlete injury management and treatment.

National Sports Injury Database – Sports Injury Researchers Needed

The National Sports Injury Database (NSID) mission statement is to help reduce the occurrence of sports injuries through objective injury surveillance.

Non-identified real-time injury data (currently over 500,000 recorded injuries) from participating SWOL Users will be available to the NSID for research purposes. We believe this relationship will create the largest real-time high school and college sports injury database in the US.

The NSID is assembling a 5 to 7 person Advisory Board to guide the injury surveillance procedures, studies and promotions. If you or someone you know has an interest in participating at any level please contact Rob Potash at 781-297-2034 x106.



Facilitate Neuromuscular Control – HUMAC360

Does control of movement count during training? Is so how do you control linear movement for your patients? Assign a tech, place the patient in front of a mirror or ask them to count s-l-o-w-l-y? If so, consider the HUMAC360 Exercise Guidance System. The HUMAC360 provides real-

time visual feedback so patients can self-correct during exercise.

Attach the HUMAC360 to the patient (such as their hip for a squat pattern) or the weight stack, select a velocity protocol, set start and stop points, press Go and watch what happens. Instead of over or under compensating range-of-motion or moving too fast or too slow movements are on target and efficient.
